This form should be used to transfer ownership of an electronic Oklahoma title. It can **ONLY** be used if the current title on record is electronic.

Additional forms may be required in conjunction with this form.

Possible forms may include:

- Purchase agreement
- Declaration of Purchase Price (Form 722-1)
- Federal Odometer statement (Form 729), etc.

Please also note:

- If the vehicle is newer than 2011, a Federal Odometer statement will be required in conjunction with this form.
- If this vehicle was purchased from a dealer, a purchase agreement will be required to be submitted.
- If this was purchased from an individual, a declaration of purchase price will be required.
